Introduction

Copy and paste your manuscript into the template using Microsoft Word. Open the Styles tool; all styles associated with ECSR begin with an asterisk. Opening paragraphs (*FirstParaofSectionTextStyle) should have no indentation. Headers should fit on one line and be in title case. The first-tier header should be in 12 pt. Avenir Next LT Pro font, and body text should be in 10 pt. Sabon Next LT font.

Subsequent paragraphs (*SubsequentParagraphsTextStyle) should be indented. The Eighteenth Edition of *The Chicago Manual of Style Author-Date* format must be followed. Other referencing styles and footnote citation systems are not allowed.

Block quotations (*BlockQuote) should be indented by 0.5 inches, should not include quotation marks, and should end with a parenthetical citation after the period. Block quotes should be used when quoting fifty words or more. (Author Surname year published, page number)

First-Tier Header

The first-tier header (*SectionHeadings) should be used for the main headings. All paragraphs must consist of three sentences or more. Articles must be a minimum of 4,000 words to a maximum of 8,000 words. Only the main text is included in this word count. Articles must follow conventions of United States English in regard to proper grammar, punctuation, and typical writing practices.

Text should be single spaced. Spaces should only exist between paragraphs when using block quotes, as seen above. Please do not adjust the font scale or spacing.

Second-Tier Header

JOURNAL TITLE

The second-tier header (*SectionSubheading1) is used for sections within the main headings. The second-tier header should be in 11 pt. Avenir Next LT Pro Light font. Headers should not be numbered.

- Lists should be in 10 pt. Sabon Next LT font.
- Lists should use square bullet points.

Please do not alter the margins or page size. Pages must always be in portrait layout. Information in the headers will be updated when the article is typeset.

Third-Tier Header

The third-tier header (*SectionSubheading2) is used for sections within subheadings. The third-tier header should be in 10.5 pt. Avenir Next LT Pro Light font and italics. Please insert all images as jpg files. Please keep image resolution below 300 DPI.

When inserting tables and figures, position them after the paragraph in which they are described. All tables should be editable in Word. A source line is not required if the table/figure was created by the authors for this article.

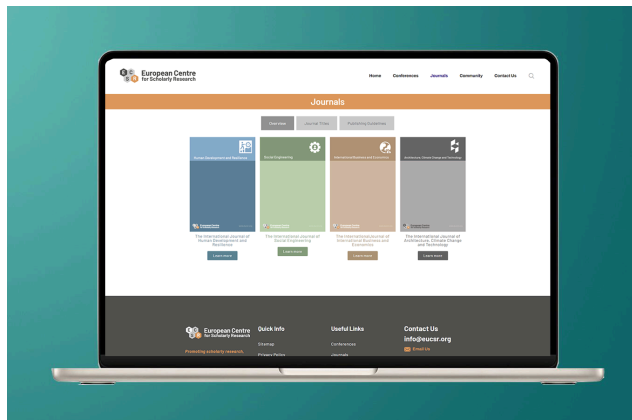


Figure 1: Caption of the Figure in Title Case (*FigureCaption)
